Preventing disease or catching it early is preferable to allowing disease to develop and progress.

NOTE: 75% of pets over the age of 3 have dental disease. Dental plaque, oral diseases, and other conditions can cause bad breath. Brushing your pet's teeth and having regular dental cleanings are beneficial for your pet and your pocketbook. Advanced dental disease can be painful to your pet and costly to treat.

**Please note that this is a wellness schedule. If your pet becomes ill, additional tests may be necessary.
